



2021 Boat Sharing Program at North Shore Yacht Club

The 2021 Boat Share program at the NSYC allows you, your family and friends to use a well-maintained, well-equipped Colgate 26 sailboat without the need to buy, insure or deal with the worries that come with owning a boat. Our boat share boat, **Under Toad**, is cooperatively maintained by Boat Share participants (who want to learn how to care for a boat), experienced club members and paid professionals.

The program is open only to members of the NSYC and runs from Club Commissioning in May to Club De-Commissioning in October.

How to join the Boat Share Program: In order to participate in the boat share program you have to be a member of the club.

For those joining the Club to participate in this program, the path via Social Associate membership is ideal. The Social Associate fee for an individual or family is \$750/year, plus the Boat Share program fee of \$850/year. ******(you need to pass a proficiency test before you can take the boat out)

For a total cost of \$1600 (plus tax) for the season, you are a member of the Club and Boat Share Program. You and your family can enjoy the use of the boat and the full social, entertainment and educational benefits of the club. In addition, each member commits to volunteering 8 hours to maintain Under Toad and other volunteer work.

Don't Know how to Sail but Want to Learn? Instruction is available for individuals or small groups with our Certified Sailing Instructor or a designated member of the Boat Share Committee.

How to Sign-up and Sail: There is a simple on-line sign-up procedure to reserve the Boat Share boat. Reservation slots are set up for weekends, holidays, during the week and early evenings. Program guidelines assure fair and equal access to sign-up times and use of the boat.
