



**Covid Guidance  
For  
North Shore Yacht Club (NSYC)  
Borden Cup Race  
June 13, 2021**

**Note:** In conversation with YRALIS, most clubs are referring entrants to check their website rather than publish their Covid 19 protocols in race notices or sailing instructions. NSYC has decided to do the same.

Crews race at their own risk, so it is really up to skippers and crews to comply. Please use discretion in selecting crew and crew size. Once on the boat, please post the crew members as far away as possible from each other, and **STRONGLY** advise wearing a mask... Ideally, boat crews and Race Committees should either be fully-vaccinated, family or wear masks and social distance.

As many of our members are not vaccinated, or are not fully-vaccinated plus two weeks, the mask mandate remains in place at the club. We are allowing you to bring guests, but as we do not know their status, this is another unknown. Also, as many people are aware, there is something called "breakthrough infection" currently plaguing the Yankees, and a vaccinated person with no symptoms could infect a non-vaccinated person if they have the virus in their nasal passage and they sneeze near them. We also have non-vaccinated children in our midst.

So, having said that, masks must be worn on the docks and on the launches and social distancing must be observed. Anyone not following this protocol will not be allowed on the launch and will be asked to leave the club immediately. Please do not complain to the launch drivers or Captain Vic as they are following the directions that I have given them. If you are on the deck and seated with people you know, you may remove your masks. If you are uncertain of their status, please keep your mask on when you are not eating or drinking. Everyone inside the building must wear a mask, and eating inside is strictly forbidden except when sanctioned by the club.

Please help me in keeping everyone safe for this summer so we can all enjoy the club we love. I appreciate your cooperation in this manner and hopefully we will have an awesome summer!
