Time: 1st Warning approximately 1800 Hours.

Start: At the *Worry Wart*, the yellow Race Committee (RC) barge approx. 0.5 miles West of the Port Washington YC in the Southern end of Manhasset Bay

Finish: Green Flasher "1" off Plum Point, Manhasset Bay.

Course: Government Buoys as marks as announced and posted by the RC.

Entry Fee: \$50.00

Divisions: PHRF Spinnaker & Non-Spinnaker Divisions.

Sailing Instructions & Scratch Sheets: This is your Notice of Race (NOR).

Sailing Instructions (SI) will be on the NSYC website (<https://www.nsync.net/sailing/racing>) at least one week prior to the race. Scratch Sheets and SI will be emailed to all entrants not later than Friday, August 25th, will be available at 1630 hours on Saturday, August 26th, 2023 at NSYC and from the *Worry Wart* prior to the 1st Warning.

Courses: Approximately 18 miles for the Non-Spinnaker division and 30 miles for the Spinnaker Division subject to the courses posted before the Warning signal for each Division. Traditionally, this race finishes around midnight.

Trophies & Prizes will be awarded at the NSYC Annual Awards Event.
