

NSYC Docking procedure

Boat Share boats may be docked on the NSYC dock only.

- 1) The tide needs to be high enough to come in. Undertoad's keel draws 4' 6" and Elusive's draws 3' 11".
- 2) Get permission to come to the dock. Just radio in and ask.
- 3) Ask where they would like you to tie up.
- 4) Determine your approach. You should approach the dock as close to upwind as possible.
- 5) The fenders must be attached and dock lines must be tied and ready to throw. Tie the fenders on the wide area of the hull about 1/3 back from the bow and 1/3 up from the stern.
 - Tie the fenders so that the fender tops are a few inches below the gunwale
- 6) You must come in under power only. Do not sail into the dock. Steer with the tiller, not the engine.

Do not jump from or into the boat. A leading source of injuries involves jumping back or forth from a dock to a boat.
